



EMCCC Communications Policy

One of the primary benefits of the Eastern Montgomery County Chamber of Commerce, (EMCCC), is the opportunity for members to actively communicate with one another in the quest of networking, learning and conducting business. The Chamber actively presents a number of events such as business card exchanges and networking meetings to provide a forum for communication among members. The EMCCC website, membership directory and chamber newsletter also provide opportunities for member-to-member communication.

EMCCC wants to ensure that all communication among members is done in a professional and legal manner and has established the following guidelines:

I. Member To Member Communication and Solicitation

- a) **Telemarketing.** Members are encouraged to do business and contact fellow members by telephone. Member contact names and phone numbers are available in the annual membership directory which is also available on the EMCCC website. Members must always present themselves in a courteous and professional manner, and need to be aware of federal and state restrictions regarding telemarketing such as the “Do Not Call” registry.
- b) **Faxing.** Many member fax numbers are published in the EMCCC Membership Directory. Faxes must be presented in a professional manner, and members need to be aware of state and federal laws regarding faxing such as the “Do Not Fax” law.
- c) **Email.** Many member email addresses are published in the EMCCC Membership Directory. Emails must be presented in a professional manner, and members need to be aware of state and federal laws regarding emails, such as the “Can Spam” law.
- d) **EMCCC mailing list** is available for purchase and use by EMCCC members only.
